


China-Tibet And 19th Party Congress

November 8, 2017

Soon after the 19th Party Congress (October 18 - 24, 2017) held in Beijing, the Chinese-appointed 11th Panchen Lama said that the 19th National Congress of the Communist Party of China (CPC) could benefit Buddhism and called on all Buddhists to be grateful to the homeland. Tibet.cn quoted Panchen Lama Bainqen Erdini Qoigyijabu on November 8, 2017, as saying at the opening ceremony for a seminar on interpreting Tibetan Buddhist doctrine in Beijing on November 6, that 'Xi Jinping Thought on Socialism with Chinese Characteristics for a New Era' could be a guiding light for Buddhism in adapting to socialism with Chinese characteristics and continuing to develop. He said the interpretation of Tibetan Buddhist doctrine should also include consolidating its current achievements and respecting its traditions, while being aware of the developments and the needs of Tibetan areas, or the whole of China. He said that Buddhists should be grateful for the nation, for life, for their parents, and the three jewels - Buddha, the Dharma, and the Sangha - and return the offerings of the grace of the homeland and life. He added that interpreting doctrine involves "digging and promoting what benefits social harmony, development, health, and civilization in the religious doctrine, morality and culture."

(Comment: China's official news agency Xinhua said the Panchen Lama is currently Vice President of the Buddhist Association of China and a member of the Standing Committee of the Chinese People's Political Consultative Conference (CPPCC) National Committee.)

Panchen Lama inaugurates the Seventh Annual Seminar on Tibetan Buddhist Doctrine Interpretation November 2017

The Chinese appointed Panchen Lama Gyaltsen Norbu, inaugurated the seventh Annual Seminar on Tibetan Buddhist Doctrine Interpretation at Tibetan Buddhism College of China in Beijing on November 06, 2017. In his keynote speech, the Chinese appointed Panchen Lama recalled a meeting that he had with Xi Jinping on June 10, 2015 whereby the General Secretary pointed out the "need to actively engage in the interpretation of Tibetan Buddhist doctrine, carrying forward the positive spirits in Tibetan Buddhism, such as propagating the good and repress the bad, equality and tolerance, and helping the poor and people in need" The Panchen Lama reportedly told the participants of 200 people encompassing of "Scholars Han Buddhist monasteries, religious research institutions, representatives from Buddhist Institutes and monasteries" from Tibet and Tibetan areas of Qinghai, Gansu, Sichuan and Yunnan Province that the Buddhist monks should carry Buddhist traditions of patriotism and

uphold national ethnic unity.

United Front Activity

As part of activities sponsored by the Party's United Front Work Department, meetings were organised to propagate the teachings and spirit of the 19th Party Congress among Tibetans living in frontier areas and to help them appreciate the Party's contributions to improving their standard of life. In the end of October and early November, the officers and soldiers of the Tibetan border police station in Zanda County, Ali District of Tibet, conducted a 'grand' activity to propagate the 19th Party Congress among the herder masses in the area. One 73-year old man living in Dhaba said that "Now living conditions are getting better. In the past, we had enough to eat, not to eat, wear and tear, and get sick. The government can also reimburse most of the medical expenses. I am very satisfied with the present life." He also told the guards that "In the past two years, the village has developed very fast, a great change has taken place since the past year." He added that he is looking forward when the Chinese dream of building a moderately prosperous society will be accomplished. He also said that during 2000 there were no roads and no facilities and "we used to travel for days to reach Xinjiang which is 1400 km away, but now national highway no: 219 has been constructed in Tibet and there is an airport in Ali district". Saying he has personally witnessed the development, he observed, "our district has now become prosperous".

On October 31, the Vice Chairman of the Standing Committee of the Tibet Autonomous Region Party Committee and Chief Director of Poverty Alleviation Headquarters Luo Budunzhu convened the 13th anti-poverty headquarters meeting. The meeting studied and discussed the "Demonstration Request for Recognition of Rural Villages in Depressed Poverty Counties", the "Implementing Opinions on Supporting Poverty Alleviation in Poverty stricken areas," the "Outline the report of Tibet's Poverty Alleviation from Poverty stricken Areas" in the Tibet Autonomous Region. Luo Budunzhu stressed the need to adhere to the people-centered development thinking and earnestly grasp the first priority of getting rid of poverty and tackling the overall situation of economic and social development in an all-out way to speed up the overall economic and social development of the indepth poverty-stricken areas in Tibet.

Luo Budunzhu also said at the conference that 6739 households in five impoverished counties and 23,285 poor people were lifted out of poverty in 2016, and that the incidence of poverty had dropped below 3%. As of the end of September 2017, the Tibet Autonomous Region has invested a total of more than 20 billion yuan (RMB) in various types of financial agriculture-related funds and 10 billion yuan in a special fund for industrial poverty alleviation, directly bringing 92,000 people out of poverty. He added that education aid is also intensifying and Tibet has started free secondary vocational education through special enrollment of children of impoverished families and "children born after year 2000" to receive free education to stop inter-generational transmission of poverty.

Meeting to discuss development of Yumai Village

November 10, 2017

TAR Standing Committee Member and Executive Vice Chairman of TAR People's Government Jiang Jie convened a meeting on November 7, 2017 to discuss the development of Yumai village of Lhunze County of Lhoka (Ch: Shannan).

The meeting discussed General Secretary Xi Jinping's reply to a letter sent by two Tibetan sisters, Dolkar and Yangzom, who have been living in the village with their family since 1979 as herders. Xi Jinping acknowledged the family's efforts to safeguard the territory and thanked them for the loyalty and contributions they have made in the border area. The village, with 32 inhabitants, is situated on the India-China border across Arunachal Pradesh. Xi Jinping said, "Without peace in the territory, there will be no peaceful lives for millions of families." He hoped that this case would motivate more herders to put down roots in the border area "like Kalsang flowers and become guardians of the Chinese territory and constructors of a happy hometown.

The meeting also discussed promoting developmental construction in Yumai village so as to protect it from Indian invasion as claimed by the family in their letter. The officials at the meeting were told to quickly formulate plans, strengthen organizational leadership and monitor progress.

Lhasa-Damchuka Tourist train to open in 2018

November 01, 2017

According to the TAR Tourism Development Commission, an agreement was signed between Tibet Travel Corporation and Qinghai-Tibet Railway Corporation to operate a tourist train from Lhasa to Damchuka (Ch: Damxung). The Lhasa-Damchuka tourist train will provide convenient and safe transportation for tourists travelling to core scenic spots of the "world's third polar national park" including Namtso and Siling Co as well as the Damchuka. The train is scheduled to commence operations on July 1, 2018.

Officials fan out to spread the spirit of 19th Party congress

November 11, 2017

Lectures to explain and publicise the spirit of the 19th Party Congress have been held by Party and Government Officials across "China's Tibet" including in Lhasa. Mu Hong, a member of the group and Deputy Director of China's National Development and Reform Commission, spoke to residents of Sanyou village in Lhasa on November 10, on how to implement the spirit of the 19th Party Congress. More than 900 local CCP members and officials attended another of Mu Hong's lectures in Lhasa the previous day. TAR Party Secretary Wu Yingjie said the region would further promote the spirit of the Congress to companies, schools, monasteries and farming and stock-breeding areas. Promoting the spirit of the 19th Party Congress, he said, should be based on the region's

reality. The lecture group mainly comprised officials and scholars who were involved in drafting documents of the 19th Party Congress.

(Comment: The first lecture was held in Beijing on November 3 and attended by more than 3,000 people including local Party officials, company representatives and teachers and students from universities. In the first week of November the lecturers have spoken to groups in provinces across the country, including Heilongjiang, Jilin, Shanxi, Anhui, Fujian Yunnan and Hainan.

TAR Leaders visit exhibitions on Poverty Alleviation

November 09, 2017

TAR Party Secretary Wu Yingjie, Chairman of the TAR People's Congress Lobsang Gyaltsen, Chairman of TAR People's Government, Qi Zhala, TAR CPPCC Party Secretary Ding Yexian, Executive Vice Chairman of TAR Party Committee Jiang Jie and other TAR leaders like Wang Yongjun, Zeng Wangming, Penpa Tashi and Pema Wangdue visited the opening ceremony of an exhibition held in Lhasa highlighting the achievements of poverty alleviation projects.

TAR Party Secretary Wu Yingjie reiterated General Secretary Xi Jinping's emphasis during the 19th Party Congress on overcoming poverty in poor and rural areas and together building a "well off society". Potala Palace to undergo large renovation

November 09, 2017

Xinhua reported on November 9, 2017, that a major renovation project would soon begin at the 1300 years old UNESCO listed world heritage site of Potala Palace. The State Administration of Cultural Heritage approved the 'grand' project. The project will focus on repairing the palace's gold-plated roof and improving its security surveillance system. Jorden, an official of the Potala Palace administration body said that parts of the gold plating

have been damaged by long-term exposure to wind, sun and rain. He said renovation would help to protect the roof from natural exposure and prolong its life.

The project will cost more than 10 million yuan (1.5 million U.S. dollars). Last year, 1.37 million domestic and international tourists visited the palace. Over the past two decades, the central government has spent nearly three billion yuan protecting cultural heritage in Tibet.

Labrang Monastery under renovation

October 29, 2017

Local authorities announced that the prominent Labrang Monastery Tibetan Buddhist monastery in Gansu province has completed the restoration of 12 Buddha halls. It is part of a larger 300million-yuan (US\$ 45 million) preservation project to renovate Labrang Monastery, one of the largest temples of the Gelug sect of Tibetan Buddhism.

The project, which began in 2012, focused on reinforcing structural elements, restoring paintings and frescos, as well as improving safety. According to Sonam Gyatso, who is in charge of protecting the monastery's artifacts, the renovated halls will soon be open to the public while repairs of paintings and frescos are going on. Located in Xiahe county in the Tibetan autonomous prefecture of Gansu (Amdo), the Labrang Monastery was built in 1709 and has been a national cultural protection site since 1982. "The renovated Labrang Monastery will better serve as a religious venue and a place to preserve Tibetan Buddhist culture." Renovation work will be suspended in winter due to cold weather and resume in May.

Ma Shengchang presided over the 45th Standing Committee Meeting of the First Committee of the Nyingtri Party Committee

November 10, 2017

On November 9, Nyingtri Party Secretary Ma Shengchang presided over the 45th Standing Committee Meeting of the Nyingtri Standing Committee.

Zhao Shuming, Deputy Mayor of the Municipal Committee, Xu Dianhui, Executive Vice Mayor and Deputy Secretary of the Municipal Party Committee, Liu Yeqiang, Minister of the Organization Department, Wang Chunding, Member of the Municipal Public Security Bureau, Vice Mayor Zhanggeng Yun, Vice-Chairman of United Front Work Department and Deputy Secretary of the Municipal Committee Dawa, and Propaganda Minister Zhang Haibo attended the meeting.

The meeting was to study the spirit of the 19th Party Congress and the first six plenary sessions of the work report of Nyingtri (Ch: Linzhi). The draft proposal of "Linzhi City Housing and Urban construction from the "Thirteenth Five-Year" Plan (2016- 2020)" and the CPC Nyingtri People's Government Party Committee on Auditing the Allocation of Funds to facilitate Poverty Alleviation projects in 2017 were also presented.

During the meeting, Ma Shengchang emphasized on the past achievements in development, economics and poverty alleviation. He expressed confidence in the future development under the leadership of General Secretary Xi Jinping and his new vision of China. He whole-heartedly welcomed a new era of socialism with Chinese characteristics. City leaders Sanjay Jampa, Xiao He, Ding Yonghui and Wang Jun attended the meeting.

Preliminary survey for an underground Tibet-Nepal OBOR railway line concluded

November 14, 2017

A railway line linking Tibet with Nepal has begun taking concrete shape with the two sides having concluded a preliminary study. The cross-border 100-km railway will connect Kathmandu and Tibet's border town of Kerung (Tibetan: Kyirong or Kyidrong).

A Chinese delegation including experts on high-altitude railway technology and Nepali engineers jointly concluded that the railway would be underground and cost around Nepalese Rs 275 billion. It said a 23-member Chinese delegation led by Zheng Jian, Deputy Administrator (Vice Minister), of China's National Railway Administration, concluded a five-day study tour on November 10. The report said about 85 percent of the railroad will be underground and will pass beneath the hills from Kerung, which is at an altitude of 4000 metres, to Kathmandu (1400 metres).

The report quoted Ananta Acharya, Director General of Nepal's Department of Railway, as saying, "This was a basic research of the topology and geography. Both sides will later reach an agreement for carrying out a feasibility study." The report said the study was part of the One Belt One Road (OBOR) agreement, which the government of Nepal had signed with China in May. Acharya was quoted as saying, "The Chinese team is excited to proceed with the project and we have expressed our commitment to take the project ahead."

Once the railroad is complete, trains from Kyirong will operate at speeds of 120 km per hour and reach Kathmandu in less than an hour.

Activities of Tibetans inside and Abroad

Dissatisfaction with service reason for replacing Representative of North America Office of Tibet

November 10, 2017

The Kashag (Cabinet) of the Central Tibetan Administration (CTA) explained on November 9 that its Representative at the Office of Tibet in Washington, DC, Penpa Tsering, was replaced due to dissatisfaction with his service. Officiating President and Kalon (Minister) Karma Gelek Yuthok of the Department of Religion and Culture told the media that the Kashag had expressed its dissatisfaction with the way the current Representative had discharged his responsibilities since he assumed office last August. Tibet, net said on November 9 "In fact, in

July this year, the Kashag sent the last advisory mentioning the need for improvement in the ways and manners of his service and performance." It said three such advisories had been sent thus far.

(Comment: Penpa Tsering was appointed as the Representative at the Office of Tibet, Washington, DC, in August last year. He was the losing candidate in the Sikyong election that year.)
